#### **1957 Buffalo Air-Park (BAP)**


*Cars were sprouting tail fins. Elvis, Debbie Reynolds and the Everly Brothers were on the radio. Ed Sullivan was a popular show on black and white TV. Things were upbeat at the airports too. The Cessna 172 was introduced but taildraggers were still everywhere. Economical fun flying was at its best!*

*This is not just another aviation video but rather a snapshot of the area through the eyes of Dr. Florian Dzimian. This Orchard Park dentist first recorded it on 16 mm film. Later it was transferred to VHS and DVD by Mark Mekker of Mekker Video Productions. He produced it and donated copies to the Aero Club of Buffalo to use for gifts and fundraising.*


*Please read the jacket cover that describes some things you will see that are gone forever and others yet to be. It is truly a fleeting moment in time!*

This DVD video is a transfer from a 16mm film shot and produced by F. J. Dzimian at Buffalo Air Park in 1957. It shows many interesting scenes for those familiar with Western New York. Buffalo Air Park still has its two runways, its big main hangar still stands, and there is no Kmart approach. Many of the aircraft seen in this video were new or less than 10 years old at the time. One of the Aeronca Champs is still flying and is located in Mt Morris, another has found a home in Jasper, Indiana, and yet another now resides in Savannah, Georgia. The New York State Thruway is still under construction. Bethlehem and Republic steel are still issuing forth the dark clouds and noxious odors that those of us who drove down route 5 will never forget. The Canadiana is intact and docked in the harbor where it used to depart with its passengers to the fun at Crystal Beach. War Memorial Auditorium hasn't had its roof raised yet. The American side of Niagara Falls is absent the observation tower that was such an eye sore. Buffalo International Airport still has the Curtiss Wright buildings intact where so many aircraft were built and where thousands labored during WWII, and across the street Calspan is yet to have fully expanded.


But one thing hasn't changed and that is the beauty of a taildragger, the allure of a clear blue sky, and man's love of flying!

## **Modernization of Special Airworthiness Certification (MOSIAC)**

---

### **Key Changes in the MOSAIC Rule:**

- **Aircraft Capabilities:**
- **Increased Speed:** MOSAIC allows for higher maximum speeds for light-sport aircraft, potentially up to 250 knots.

- **More Complex Systems:** The rule permits more advanced systems, including retractable landing gear, constant-speed propellers, and various propulsion systems like electric and hybrid options.
- **Increased Size:** MOSAIC allows for aircraft with up to four seats, though sport pilots will still be limited to carrying one passenger, [according to the FAA](#).
- **Stall Speed:** The rule is based on a clean stall speed, with a likely cap between 54 and 63 knots.
- **Weight:** By permitting higher stall speeds, the proposal would bring aircraft weighing as much as 3,000 pounds within the LSA regulatory framework, says the FAA.
- **Pilot Privileges:**
- **Potential for Simplified Medicals:** The MOSAIC rule may maintain sport pilot privileges, potentially allowing pilots to operate expanded LSA capabilities without a medical certificate, though this remains under review.
- **Endorsements:** Pilots may need specific endorsements for certain aircraft features or operations, like night flying or operating aircraft with more complex systems.

December 2024 changes made through the FAA Reauthorization Act of 2024:

- Takeoff weight increased from 6,000 lbs. to 12,500 lbs.
- Pilot examiners can conduct flight checks in aircraft covered by BasicMed
- The duration of the comprehensive medical examination is determined using calendar months

Transport category rotorcraft certified to airworthiness standards under part 29 are **not** covered by BasicMed
